Research on Financing for Climate and Health Equity
Terms of Reference

Introduction:

Action for Global Health (AfGH) is a UK-based network of nearly 60 organisations working towards a world where the universal right to health is realised and everyone has access to the quality healthcare they need without being forced into financial hardship. AfGH works to mobilise and unite UK-based global health advocates and hold the UK government and other global health stakeholders accountable to achieve our agreed strategic goals.

AfGH is seeking a consultant to conduct initial research and develop the first draft of a short briefing on UK financing for climate change and global health equity. The report will identify key thematic areas of focus. It will make a set of recommendations for the UK to improve its financial commitments to global health equity and climate change.

AfGH's Definition of Health Equity: Individuals have parity in health outcomes; people facing disadvantage because of their specific characteristics (including age, gender, ethnicity, disability, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression and sex characteristics) and/or their socio-economic, demographic or geographic standing have access to quality, affordable healthcare services tailored to their specific health and wellbeing needs.

Project Objectives:

1. Through desk research, produce the first draft of a briefing which provides a baseline of the UK Government's commitments and action on financing for climate change and global health equity that will contribute to AfGH's advocacy work on climate change and global health equity.

Timeline of Work

We expect this work to be completed by 31 August 2024.

Outputs

- Research completed and first draft of briefing produced.
- Consultant participates in a one-hour working group to discuss the research' findings, in order for the working group to develop key recommendations.

Time involved

To be agreed, but we estimate up to five days of work in total.
