

Action for Global Health Consultancy: Parliamentary Engagement

March 2026

Introduction

[Action for Global Health](#) (AfGH) is an influential membership network convening more than 50 organisations working in global health.

Our 2022-2029 strategy outlines our vision for a world where health equity is achieved. Our 2029 strategic goal seeks to achieve strengthened actions and commitments from the UK Government, which have positively contributed towards achieving health equity, resulting in more people accessing quality, affordable healthcare tailored to their specific health and wellbeing needs.

In 2024, Action for Global Health launched our Parliamentary Influencing working group, which brings together members to engage with UK parliamentarians on key global health issues, expand our relationships with interested parliamentarians, collaborate on parliamentary events (in Westminster and at party conferences), and feed into parliamentary inquiries. This group is co-led by two member leads from Unlimit Health and Global Health Partnerships.

AfGH also chairs the All-Party Parliamentary Group (APPG) coordination group, bringing together more than 10 APPGs working across global health and development to collaborate on shared goals.

In mid-2026, we will be developing our next *Stocktake Review* (see 2024 review [here](#)), which provides a baseline understanding of the UK's political, financial and programmatic commitments to global health equity, and provides recommendations for improved UK action. We anticipate that this will be a critical resource to engage and inform parliamentarians, alongside wider reports and briefings developed this year.

Overview

We are looking to boost our organisational capacity temporarily to drive forward key aspects of our Parliamentary Influencing strategy and activities.

Project Deliverables and Timeline

We are seeking short-term consultancy support to review and update our parliamentary influencing strategy and coordinate membership consultation to refine our multiyear activity plan. This should include at least the following activities:

- Updated mapping of 10-15 key parliamentary targets to engage on global health issues (building on existing mapping, learnings from 2024-2025 engagements and changes to the political context) – *by end of June*
- Defining 2026 - 2027 parliamentary priorities and activity plan - *by end of June*
- Development of AfGH plans for engagement at 2026 party conferences – *by end of June*
- Development of approach, tactics and messaging for target and oppositional voices on global health and development – *by end of June*

- At least 2x coordinated parliamentary events – *by summer recess (16th July)*
- Scoping and coordinated submissions to at least 2x relevant parliamentary committee and APPG inquiries – *based on scoping*

Please note: the appointed consultant will have access to Polimonitor through AfGH to support the delivery of these activities.

Ideally, we would like the consultancy to be around 1 day per week between mid-April and mid-July, for a total of between 10-12 days.

Expressions of interest

Interested consultants (individuals or teams) should submit:

- A short technical proposal, of no more than two pages, outlining understanding of the assignment, proposed methodology and work plan.
- Evidence of experience of parliamentary influencing
- A budget proposal with daily rate and total cost estimate, including any travel costs to attend London-based parliamentary events
- The CV of the consultant and names of two referees
- At least one example of previous parliamentary influencing work (eg. Inquiry submission, parliamentary event etc.)
